## Ecclesia

John 21:4-7, 15-19

<sup>4</sup>Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realise that it was Jesus.

<sup>5</sup>He called out to them, "Friends, haven't you any fish?" "No," they answered.

<sup>6</sup>He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.

<sup>7</sup>Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water.

<sup>15</sup>When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love Me more than these?" "Yes, Lord," he said, "you know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Feed My lambs."

<sup>16</sup>Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you love Me?" He answered, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Take care of My sheep."

<sup>17</sup>The third time He said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love Me?" Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, "Do you love Me?" He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed My sheep."

<sup>18</sup>Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go."

<sup>19</sup>Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then He said to him, "Follow Me!"

<sup>12</sup>We are not withholding our affection from you, but you are withholding yours from us.
