

You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve. Matthew 4:10 Worship actively ascribes proper worth to God.

- 1. We worship through worship music. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. Colossians 3:16
- 2. We worship through Sabbath rest. There remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God, for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from His. Let us therefore strive to enter that rest... Hebrews 4:9-11
- 3. We worship through <u>doing good</u>. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10
- 4. We worship through <u>corporate worship</u>. The hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship Him. God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth. John 4:23-24
