About the artist:

³⁵On that day, when evening had come, He said to them, "Let us go across to the other side." ³⁶ And leaving the crowd, they took Him with them in the boat, just as He was. And other boats were with Him. ³⁷ And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling. ³⁸ But He was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" ³⁹ And He awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!" He Qi studied at Nanjing Normal University, Nanjing Art Institute in China and Hamburg Art Institute in Germany. He was the first among Mainland Chinese to earn a Ph.D. in Religious art after the Cultural Revolution (1992). He received an Honorary Doctor Degree from Australia Catholic University in Melbourne (May, 2011). His work has been displayed in museums, galleries, universities and churches around the world.
