For here we do not have an enduring city, but we are looking for the city that is to come.

Finding Jesus "outside the camp"

Hebrews 13.11-14

"Outside the camp" in the Old Testament

The bull and the goat for the sin offerings, whose blood was brought into the Most Holy Place to make atonement, must be taken outside the camp; their hides, flesh and intestines are to be burned up. The man who burns them must wash his clothes and bathe himself with water; afterward he may come into the camp.

Leviticus 16:27-28

The person with such an infectious disease must wear torn clothes, let his hair be unkempt, cover the lower part of his face and cry out, 'Unclean! Unclean!' As long as he has the infection he remains unclean. He must live alone; he must live outside the
