#### BOLD FAITH

The Bold Faith campaign has always had one end goal in mind: To reach more people with the good news of Jesus Christ by serving the community with love. We believe that in order to achieve this, we all have a part to play in establishing a permanent and purpose-filled venue in Hong Kong.

Our impact on earth has the potential to have lasting and eternal significance, depending on how we choose to invest our callings, gifts, and resources. Built within our very core is the God-given purpose to share the good news of Christ with those around us, and to do this in a way that exudes the love and characteristics He exemplified.

Throughout the city, from corporate boardrooms in Central to the cramped family spaces in Sham Shui Po, are people made in the image of God, but who have yet to discover the freedom that comes from knowing a God who loves them. The gospel message brings freedom and change. The gospel brings peace and ushers in an entirely new perspective on life.

As the gospel message impacts the city, one life at a time, the very fabric of our city changes.

After years of prayer and research, we have identified a location that could propel the gospel message to an even broader group of people.

The Bold Faith initiative is the next step in this larger story. Through your generous contributions and support, we will together be securing a permanent venue in Hong Kong to advance God's kingdom.

#### **B** • BUILD THE CHURCH

We boldly pray the gospel grows in influence and believe we have a large role to play in this expansive story. Our vision is to see more people worshipping God with transformed hearts by **building** a permanent church home for our children and future generations.

#### O • OPTIMISE TRAINING

We boldly believe that sharing the gospel of Christ creates a culture of hope around the city, spreading household to household. This starts with optimising training and leadership development opportunities.

#### L • LOVE THE CITY

We boldly prioritise acts of community service for the disadvantaged because we believe this is how Christ has called us to tangibly love those around us, especially orphans, prisoners, refugees, and hurting individuals.

#### **D** • DEEPEN RELATIONSHIPS

We boldly foster community because we believe transformation takes place through **deep** connections with others — discipleship programs, Care Groups, mission trips, and countless other focused gatherings happening outside of Sundays.

#### 1999 180 trailblazers begin a new congregation on Hong Kong Island when Evangelical Community Church (ECC) is overflowing in Tsim Sha Tsui.

#### After 18 months of guest speakers, our first full-time pastor, Brett Hilliard, begins ministry as church attendance hits 350.

2001

#### A second service time is launched. The personal preference of many to keep only one service and "know everyone" is overcome by a greater desire to reach more people

with the gospel.

2004

#### A strategic decision to secure a small 4,000 sq.ft. office and ministry centre in Wan Chai leads to greater ministry impact. Church attendance surpasses 1,000.

2006

After 8 years of wandering between 15 various worship facilities, four floors of 633 King's Road are secured, providing weekly continuity. Church members give \$25M to create attractional ministry spaces that lead to unprecedented ministry opportunities.

2007

Faith is stretched as we risk losing members by moving to Quarry Bay. However, newfound stability leads to 1.500 attendance milestone and a third service in the afternoon is launched

2008

#### As we continue to take steps of faith, we send Pastor Tobin Miller, two elders. and 180 people to plant Watermark Community Church in Pok Fu Lam. \$3.2M is given to this new church

2010

#### Desiring objective feedback on our health and direction, we enlist a global church consultant. Strategic improvements are implemented. Church consultants project growth to 5,000 people by 2018.

2011

Church surpasses 2,000 attendees as we secure an additional family-friendly worship space on 10/F.

2013

# 2015

#### Church surpasses 3,000 attendees. After six months of prayers, steps of faith are taken: a fourth service is made available at 3pm, 11/F is opened for the Youth and Filipino ministries, and Bold Faith Campaign is launched.

#### Over \$140M is raised for funding the Bold Faith campaign. Target: an entire building or multiple floors, with 63,000+ sq. ft. on Hong Kong Island.

Island ECC signed an agreement for the Redevelopment Project at 210 Java Road.

# ISLAND ECC REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

### 210 JAVA ROAD, NORTH POINT

Our team of experts explored locations all across Hong Kong Island, but God opened the door for us just down the road at 210 Java Road. This new location, if approved, will provide space to accommodate a vast amount of church and ministry activities and social services. Securing a larger, permanent, and customised space will increase our immediate impact on the city, and with this increased visibility, more people can benefit.

We have identified a unique opportunity to redevelop a Government, Institution, or Community (GIC) site located at 210 Java Road in North Point. In seeking out a new location, our goal was to be convenient both for our congregation and the community we hope to serve.

#### PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITY

We have the opportunity to move forward with this project in partnership with North Point Kai-Fong Welfare Advancement Association and Women's Welfare Club which have been serving the community for over 50 years. This is a win-win collaboration that leverages years of our expertise and resources to reach out and serve residents and the local community to enrich lives in Hong Kong.

#### NORTH POINT KAI-FONG WELFARE ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION

Their objectives are to provide a facility for neighbours to help and love each other. They serve the community, including children, youth and elderly.

#### WOMEN'S WELFARE CLUB (EASTERN DISTRICT) HONG KONG

They exist to help and serve the women, children, and elderly of Hong Kong Island's Eastern district.

Island ECC's desire to serve the community in tangible ways, combined with these two partnering organisations, creates an opportunity for exponential impact in our city.





#### THE NEXT CHAPTER


Our church started in 1999 with 180 faith-filled individuals in Wan Chai. As nomads, we rented space weekly to hold gatherings and quickly doubled in size. After eight years of wandering between various rented venues, Island ECC secured our current location on King's Road and our ministries have grown exponentially, and have needed to expand to more floors over time. We saw the impact a dedicated space for ministry had on church growth and lives changed. Now, we imagine what securing a larger, permanent venue could do to reach even more lives with the gospel.

#### THE PROPOSED BUILDING

We will design this new space from the ground up, which allows us to fully customise each unique venue based on ministry needs. With 20 floors dedicated to ministry and community services, the project is anticipated to provide a gross floor area of approximately 14,500m². Spaces for leadership training, community, small group and social gatherings abound beyond the dedicated spaces for our already established and vibrant ministries. A highlight will be our own rooftop garden, a perfect location as a multi-functional space.

Our team of architects will be working to ensure the new building is modern, multi-level and customised to enhance the experience of our ministry demographics: children and youth, elderly, young professionals, families with special needs, minorities, refugees, and the displaced and marginalised in Hong Kong.

The centrepiece in our new building will be our worship auditorium. Designed creatively with a community focus, the space will hold approximately 1,000 people, including a large balcony and elevated stage.

We are committed to maintaining our distinctness as a church, and the new spaces will allow us to expand our care to the city in practical and needed ways.





#### FUND RAISING, FAITH RAISING,

#### THE PROJECT

Now is the moment to respond to God's calling to give generously to the Bold Faith Fund. This is Island ECC's most important initiative for a building project to impact the community for growing social services and ministry in the Eastern District and throughout Hong Kong for future generations. The goal is to raise 70% or \$615,500,000 of the estimated project cost by 2022 for the church to show financial capacity for applications to the various government departments. The financial capability support could be in the form of giving and pledges in 1-5 years commitments from donors. The construction period is planned to commence in 2024, so sufficient funding is a prerequisite before demolition at the current site. We invite you to give generously as an act of stewardship to the Bold Faith Fund.

Though all information and projections are done in good faith, there is no assurance that the estimated redevelopment cost, as highlighted, will be sufficient to complete the project or that all necessary government approvals will be secured.






BOLD FAITH PLEDGES AND GIVING AS OF 31 MARCH 2021




GIVING AND PLEDGE MODEL (FIVE YEARS)

## PRAY ABOUT YOUR INVOLVEMENT

Here is a sample prayer to guide you: "Lord, show me how You want me to be a part of Your kingdom work in Hong Kong. Show me practical ways I can give that will stretch my faith, and provide for Your church." Remember that God is more concerned about your faith being stretched than the amount that you give.

#### REMEMBER

# REMEMBER THE BIBLICAL PRINCIPLE: "EQUAL SACRIFICE, NOT EQUAL GIFTS"

While some are able to give bigger amounts than others, we truly believe that God is honoured with our unity in sacrifice. Perhaps another way to discern your giving amount to the Lord is not to ask how much you can afford to give but how much you actually need to keep for yourself.

#### DETERMINE

# DETERMINE WHAT WILL GUIDE YOUR DECISION: REASON OR REVELATION

Decisions based on reason is the most common way people give to charities. When I give based on reason, I simply look at my finances, determine a "reasonable" amount, and then I donate. It is an act of unselfishness, but it requires no faith, no sacrifice, and therefore limits the opportunity to see God perform a miracle. Reason asks: "What can I afford to give?"

But there's an even better way to give:

Decisions based on **revelation** require faith and are determined by prayer and a willingness to have your faith stretched. The people of Macedonia were honoured by God because "they gave not only what they could afford, they gave even more than they could afford." (2 CORINTHIANS 8:3)

# UNDERSTAND THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A STEWARD AND A DONOR

A donor helps out an organisation by giving. A steward recognises that everything belongs to God and is responsible for managing the resources He has given them.

Giving can be a source of frustration if you feel obligated or manipulated. Alternatively it can be a great source of worship if you are able to yield it to God with a sense of delight and trust.
